Chocolate laxatives often look and taste just like regular chocolate.



Bright Red Decongestant Pills

Red decongestant pills often look like cinnamon candy or red M&M's®.



Oblong Capsules or Pills

Oblong capsules or pills can look like Mike and Ikes®, jelly beans, Tic Tacs®, or Good & Plenty.
