There are unexpected dangers lurking around in all corners. No place is safe, not even your home. This is the story of 2-year-old Brianna Florer who seemed fine one minute and was fighting for her life the next.

Brianna's parents first noticed that something was wrong when the little girl developed a mild fever. They thought it was a regular fever, but fate had something very unpleasant in store for them. If someone swallows a button battery, it becomes activated and creates an electric current after coming in contact with saliva. This then produces caustic soda or sodium hydroxide, which is a very corrosive compound that could eat away at the inside of your body. When swallowed, the battery travels inwards, all the while dissolving and damaging the delicate lining of your esophagus and stomach. This can put your life at serious risk and you could die if you don't receive medical attention in time.

A popular news publication reported that between the years 2005 and 2014, close to 12,000 children had reportedly swallowed these kinds of button batteries. This number is from reported cases, so no one really knows the real number.

Poor Brianna made an innocent mistake of swallowing a shiny button battery and paid with her life. Her devastated family members hope that her story will help other parents understand how important it is to monitor their children's activities and make sure they never come in contact with anything dangerous.

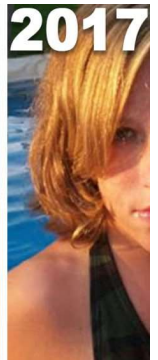
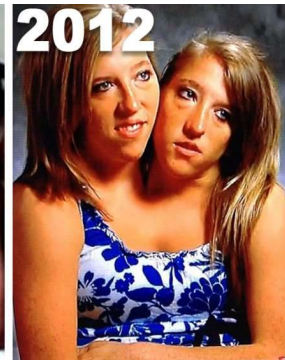
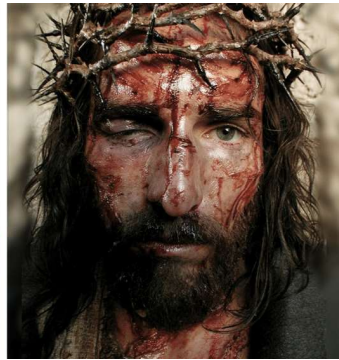
